| Week 1 | How can we stay safe? |
| Notes | <p>Explain how we can keep ourselves safe. How do you stay safe at home? How do you stay safe at the park? What do other children need to know about keeping themselves safe?</p> <p>Ideas- Make a poster or a leaflet to tell other children how to stay safe, write a list of instructions for staying safe at home or outside, write a story about keeping safe.</p> |
| Week 2 | How should we keep ourselves clean? |
| Notes | <p>Explain how and why it is important to keep ourselves clean. Think of all the different ways we keep ourselves clean.</p> <p>Ideas- Write a story about keeping clean, draw and write sentences explaining how to brush your teeth or wash your hands.</p> |
| Week 3 | How can we live a healthy lifestyle? |
| Notes | <p>Explain how we can be healthy. How should we look after our bodies? What foods should we eat and why? Why is exercise important? What would happen if we didn't wash, eat healthily or exercise?</p> <p>Ideas- Create a poster or a leaflet telling people how to stay healthy, write instructions for keeping healthy, make a video or take photos of you keeping healthy and add captions.</p> |
| Week 4 | What is a healthy diet? |
| Notes | <p>How can we have a healthy diet? Which foods are healthy and unhealthy? What meals could we eat to have a healthy diet?</p> <p>Ideas- Make a poster of healthy and unhealthy foods, design a new menu for school dinners, keep a food diary for a week and record everything you eat, write a recipe for a healthy snack or make a healthy snack and bring it in to share!</p> |
| Week 5 | Explorers, what can you see? |
| Notes | <p>Our Topic for next term will be <i>Land Ahoy!</i> During this topic we will be learning about pirates and explorers.
