Homework Questions for Y5: Autumn 2
Topic - Tremendous Tudors

Week 1 w/ b 6 th November 2017	The Tower of London
Notes	In preparation for our Year 5 trip, you need to research and find out about the Tower of London. Where is it? When was it built? Who lived there? What can you see today? Draw a map of the tower and label it or make a model. Find 6 fascinating facts about this amazing historical landmark
Week 2 w/b 13 th November 2017	Feedback from the Tower of London trip
Notes	Write a letter, or a diary entry, a postcard or a magazine article about your visit to the Tower of London. What did you enjoy the most? What did you learn? What did you see? What will you remember? Would you recommend this trip to other children and why?
Week 3 w/b 20 th November 2017	Author profile - Frances Hodgson
Notes	We are studying the classic children's story, "The Secret Garden" - Write an author profile about Frances Hodgson - Find at least 8 facts about her. If you were to meet her, write down 10 questions you would ask!!!
Week 4 w/b 27 th November 2017	Find out about Tudor Exploration / or the Spanish Armada
Notes	Make a model of a Tudor ship or design a ship that would have been used for Tudor times and voyages. Make a list of key words to do with Tudor exploration e.g. galleon, scurvy, voyage, atlas, navigation and write down the meanings. Visit the website nmm.tudorexploration
Week 5 w/b 5 th December 2016	Design a Secret Garden
Notes	Using your knowledge of the Secret Garden so far, design your own secret garden to be made the following week. Your design may be historical or futuristic. What things might you have in your garden that would really excite a visitor - let your imagination run wild - for inspiration, google images of grand gardens!! Why not visit Lloyd Park for some ideas!!!
Week 6 w/b 11 th December 2017	Make Secret Garden
Notes	Using your design from last week, make a model of your Secret Garden - use empty shoe boxes, material, paint, coloured pencils, play dough . . . anything you can get your hands on!!
