Homework Questions for Y6: Autumn Term 2 2017  
Topic - Ancient Greece

Week 1	<b>The Olympics</b>
	Do some research into the Olympics. When did they begin? Where were the first Olympic games held? Who took part? Write an information leaflet advertising 'The Ancient <b>Greek</b> Olympics'.
Week 2	<b>Climate zones</b>
	Using what you have learnt about different climate zones, create a graph or chart to show the temperatures in 4 countries around the world (north, south, east and west of the globe) over a continuous period of 14 days.
Week 3	<b>Everyday life in Ancient Greece</b>
	Find out about what the Ancient Greeks used as every day household objects. Create a poster advert for an Ancient Greek household product.
Week 4	<b>Ancient Greek poetry</b>
	Find a Greek poem or nonsense rhyme, copy and recite it to someone in your family. Could you record yourself reciting it?
Week 5	<b>Major events in Ancient Greece</b>
	Find out about a major event in Ancient Greek times. Imagine you are a newspaper reporter there at the time and write a newspaper report about it.
