

Year 3 Newsletter Spring 2

Welcome back! We hope you had a relaxing half term. We are officially halfway through Year 3 and we're so proud of what you have achieved so far. There's still plenty to learn though, so let's find out what we will be focusing on this half term.

SCIENCE

In Science we will be continuing to investigating Forces and Magnets. We will learn to understand forces as pushes and pulls, and learn that friction is a force which works in the opposite direction to movement. We will also learn how magnetic forces act at a distance and explore which materials are magnetic.



HISTORY

In History lessons this term, the children will be learning about the Roman Empire. They will find out about the chronology of Roman times, some key events such as the destruction of Pompeii, how the Romans invaded and spread across Europe – and some of the people that resisted Roman rule.



<u>PSHE</u>

In PSHE, our topic is 'Healthy Me'. The children will explore how to keep their bodies healthy and learn important advice for keeping themselves safe and understanding the effects that drugs can have.




Geography

Our Geography lessons this term are focused on landscapes. The children will learn about how rocks and landscapes can be changed by different types of weathering. They will also investigate an area of the UK using their geographical skills, to learn about mountains and rivers.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

In DT we will continue our work on shell structures and apply our knowledge of joining and folding cardboard to research, design, and create freestanding structures.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION



In RE, the children will learn about the Easter story in the Christian faith to explore the question: What is 'good' about Good Friday? They will find out what happened in the Easter Story and its significance to Christians.

ART AND DESIGN

In Art, we will be finishing our project on Ancient Egyptian crafts by decorating our own 'papyrus' scrolls and creating a zine which tells a story in an artistic way. We will then move onto learning techniques for drawing and shading to create botanical-inspired artwork.



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Times for the School Day
