### Chunky Vegetable Pasta Bake

Recipe for 2 people

Cooking & Preparation time: approximately 50 minutes

#### Ingredients

160g pasta	50g cheese
1 large courgette	½ each of red, yellow and green peppers
½ medium onion	300 ml tinned, chopped
tomatoes	
2 tablespoons of olive oil	2 teaspoons of garlic puree
½ tablespoon lemon juice	½ teaspoon of sugar
Seasoning to taste	

#### Method

1. Bring a pan of salted water to the boil and cook the pasta following the pack instructions. Preheat the oven to gas 6, 200°C, fan 180°C.
2. Dice the courgette into 4cm cubes. Slice and dice your peppers into 4cm cubes. Cut and dice the onion into 4 cm cubes.
3. Put oil into the saucepan, add the onions and gently fry for 5 minutes. Add the garlic puree.
4. Add courgettes and peppers to the onion and garlic and continue to fry gently for 5 minutes, stirring occasionally
5. Add your chopped tomatoes to your vegetable mix and stir
6. Season your mix with salt, pepper, lemon juice and sugar. Simmer mix for another 5 minutes
7. Taste your mixture to ensure seasoning is correct
8. Combine the mixture and pasta, top with cheese and bake in the oven for 15 minutes.
