We have been learning space vocabulary. We have also been developing our talk in our role play and using the language that we have read in the space story books.

The children have been reading information books about space and writing down space facts. We wrote facts about the moon and made a moon book. We have also been enjoying story books based in space. This week the book of the week was 'Little Moon'

Children have been learning to order two items by weight or capacity. We have been exploring magnetic and transparent materials to use in the spaceship. The children have been very busy building and painting our rockets to fly up into space.
