Week 4 - 6.10.25

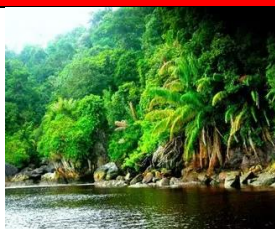
Science: States of Matter
