Monday Computing & Digital Art Club: Yrs 4, 5 & 6

(10 weeks)

Computing Club – 5 Weeks:

Next steps...

Step 1: On **Thursday 11th September** the clubs booking system for internally run clubs will **go live on Arbor at 7.15pm for Bridge site** (7pm for Forest site) pupils. You will then be able to book your child's place.

Please note that clubs will not show up on Arbor until they go live.

Step 2: To book, open your child's Arbor account, click on the **Activities** link and choose **ONE** club session for your child to join in Autumn Term (multiple signups will be deleted). Please remember it is a first come, first served system so early booking is recommended. If you have more than one child, you will need to change to each child's account and book the club for each child individually.

If the drop-down menu with the autumn dates does **not** show up, it means that the session is full as there are a limited number of spaces available for each club. In this case, you will need to make a different choice.

Arbor bookings will close at 9am on **Tuesday 16th September**

If you are having technical difficulties with Arbor, you must come to the office for assistance before the closing date.

Step 3: You will receive an email confirming your child's place. Clubs commence week of Monday 22nd September.

While Woodside clubs are limited to one per child, you can sign up to as many externally run clubs as you choose.
