# Wednesday Spanish Club

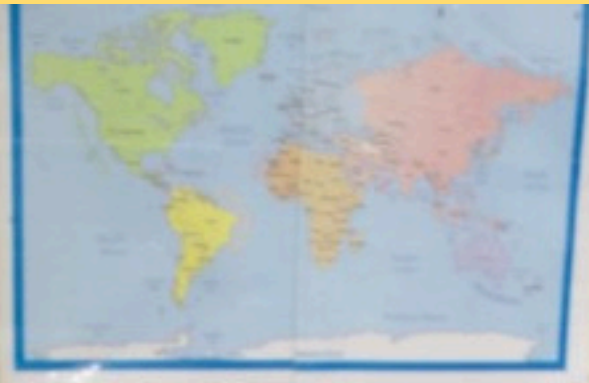
## *10 weeks*

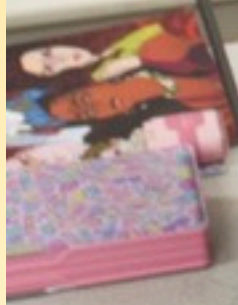

# Next steps...

**On Wednesday 3rd December the school run clubs booking system will go live on Arbor at 7.15pm for Bridge site pupils (7pm for Forest site) pupils.** You will then be able to book your child's place.

To book, open your child's Arbor account, click on the 'Activities' link and choose ONE club session for your child to join in spring term (multiple signups will be deleted). Please remember it is a first come, first served system, so early booking is recommended. If you have more than one child, you will need to change to each child's account and book the club for each child individually.

If the drop-down menu with the spring dates does not show up, it means that the session is full. There are a limited number of spaces available for each club. In this case, you will need to make a different choice.

**Arbor bookings will close at 9am on Tuesday 9th December**

If you are having technical difficulties with Arbor, you must come to the office for assistance before the closing date.

You will receive an email confirming your child's place on Wednesday 17th December.

**Spring clubs will start on Monday 12th January.**
