Monday Young Entrepreneurs + Street Art Club *10 weeks*

Young Entrepreneurs Club *5 Weeks*

A high-energy space where pupils:

- Brainstorm product ideas
- Learn business basics
- Practise pitching

Children explore branding, advertising, budgeting and public speaking in a creative format.

Through fun games, design tasks and role-play challenges, children discover how entrepreneurs turn ideas into reality.

The club builds confidence, teamwork and communication skills, giving every child the chance to be a leader and think like an innovator.



Street Art Club *5 Weeks*

Children will explore a wide range of street-art techniques, including bold lettering, simple graffiti styles, character design and stencil work.

Each session helps pupils develop confidence using colour, shape and expressive design, while learning how artists create impactful artwork in urban spaces.

Over the weeks, children build their skills step-by-step, working individually and collaboratively to produce a vibrant mini mural that showcases their creativity and the techniques they've mastered.

Monday

Textiles + Sustainable Art

10 weeks

Textiles

5 weeks

Children will explore the creative possibilities of fabric, texture and sustainable materials.

They will begin by examining a variety of recycled scraps before designing their own textile artwork.

Children will learn simple sewing techniques such as threading a needle, running stitch and appliqué, gradually building both skill and confidence.

The club encourages artistic expression, careful planning and imaginative design, ending with each child completing a unique textile piece to be proud of.



Sustainable Art

5 weeks



Children will take part in a special collaborative Sustainable Art project designed to transform the Bridge Reception area.

Working together, children will help plan, design and create a large-scale display using recycled and eco-friendly materials, giving them the chance to contribute to a meaningful piece of school artwork.

This hands-on project allows pupils to take pride in beautifying an important shared space while learning about teamwork, creativity and sustainability.

Team Sports

(Choose either the Tuesday
or Friday session)

10 weeks



This club offers children a lively and engaging introduction to a broad range of team sports. Each week focuses on a different team based activity, allowing pupils to build a variety of skills from coordination and agility to teamwork and strategy.

Sports such as football, basketball, tennis, dodgeball and tag rugby give children the chance to discover new interests while staying active and having fun. The programme ends with a celebratory festival session that brings together the best moments of the club.

Wednesday Spanish Club

10 weeks

Children develop their Spanish communication skills through engaging topics centred around food, holidays and everyday life. Activities include speaking, reading, listening and writing tasks designed to build fluency and confidence.

Pupils work on creative projects such as designing menus or describing holiday plans and they have opportunities to share their work with pen pals in Spain, adding real purpose to their learning.

By the end of the club, children have strengthened not only their vocabulary but also their ability to communicate clearly and enthusiastically in Spanish.



Wednesday West African Drumming *10 weeks*



Please note that members of this club will be selected by the music lead- you will not be able to sign up on Arbor.

Students will be immersed in the rhythms and traditions of West African drumming.

Using djembes and other percussion instruments, children learn rhythmic patterns, explore improvisation and develop a strong sense of timing and teamwork.

Sessions build towards simple ensemble playing, helping the children understand how different rhythms fit together. The club encourages musical expression, active listening and group collaboration, leading to a shared performance.

Thursday Multi Skills Club *10 weeks*



This club gives children a lively and engaging introduction to a broad range of sports.

Each week features a different activity, allowing pupils to build a variety of skills including:

- coordination
- agility
- balance
- teamwork
- confidence

Activities may include:

football, basketball, tennis, athletics games, tag rugby, dodgeball and more, giving children the chance to explore new interests while staying active and having fun.

Next steps...

On Monday 16th March the school run clubs booking system will go live on Arbor at 7.15pm for Bridge site pupils (7pm for Forest site) pupils. You will then be able to book your child's place.

To book, open your child's Arbor account, click on the 'Activities' link and choose ONE club session for your child to join in spring term (multiple signups will be deleted). Please remember it is a first come, first served system, so early booking is recommended. If you have more than one child, you will need to change to each child's account and book the club for each child individually.

If the drop-down menu with the spring dates does not show up, it means that the session is full. There are a limited number of spaces available for each club. In this case, you will need to make a different choice.

Arbor bookings will close at 11.59pm on Sunday 22nd March. If you are having technical difficulties with Arbor, you must come to the office for assistance before the closing date.

You will receive an email confirming your child's place on Thursday 26th March.

Summer clubs will start on Monday 20th April.
