



Sports Premium Impact

Case Study: Friendly Sports Fixtures

We noticed that some of our children felt overwhelmed when they attended the Borough wide School Games Competitions resulting in them under performing and being put off from attending further competitions.

To help with this our Sports Premium funding is being used to release our PE Teacher on a Friday afternoon to allow her to arrange friendly sports fixtures with other schools at Borough venues. This has allowed our pupils to experience competition in a non-threatening environment and given them the confidence they need to be successful at School Games Competitions.

This has worked particularly well with our **Athletic teams**. They have met up with Hillyfield Academy at the Waltham Forest Pool & Track had a go at the competition events (400m long distance, 60m sprint, long jump & vortex throw) and really benefitted from competing on the track. For many it was the first time they had run one lap (400m) of an athletics track, which proved to be great preparation for the Borough Competitions which followed.



Our **Year 4 Tennis squad** have also benefitted from the Sports Premium funding. They received professional coaching at the Olympic Tennis centre before attending the Borough Competition, where they performed brilliantly to progress to the tournament finals day
