Year 3 have been excited to come back to school and learn about our new theme of chocolate! The children have brought in some fantastic homework based around their favourite sweet treats and our fabulous chocolate displays are beginning to grow.

In literacy we have begun reading our new text *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* by Roald Dahl. The children have been really excited by the book and we are enjoying reading a new chapter each day. So far this week we have made predictions about the book, written questions we would like to ask Charlie and have written a character description about Grandpa Joe. We worked really hard to think of interesting adjectives, synonyms and similes which would help us describe him in lots of detail.
