This week our focus is **'PIGS'**

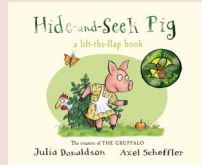
We will be learning about ducks, their names, what they look like, sound like, and discussing what they eat!

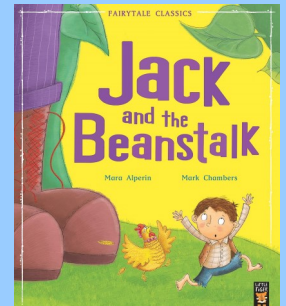
Our topic this half term is... **'FLOWERS AND GROWING'**

We will be re-allocating the sheds and new signage will be placed on them.

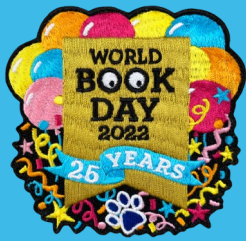
One shed will be for baby room and one for 2-year-old **DAY-CARE** children **ONLY.**

NURSERY ATTENDANCE

ATTENDANCE



At Woodside we believe attendance is very important and it is essential that your child attends their nursery place if they are **NOT** unwell, or have Covid symptoms.

We will be monitoring the children's attendance over the course of this term and we will be giving out some class prizes to the **BEST**

COVID UPDATE

If a child under 5 is identified as a close contact of someone with Covid 19, they are **NOT** required to self-isolate, unless they develop symptoms. They should **NOT** start daily testing.

If a parent/carer tests positive your child should take a **Lateral Flow Test**.

If **POSITIVE**, they should immediately begin an isolation period of **5 days**. They should take a **Lateral Flow Test** on **day 5 and day 6**, and if negative on either day can come out of their isolation period.

If **NEGATIVE**, with **no symptoms**, they should return to nursery and test again

READING BOOKS

Reading books go home on a **MONDAY** and **MUST** be returned by **THURSDAY** each week so that we can change them. Thank you.

LATENESS

It is **ESSENTIAL** for children to arrive on time for their session so that they don't miss out on their learning.

Children **MUST** be brought to nursery at the start of the session so that they can take part in carpet sessions and other focused and free play activities that we have on offer.

Children arriving **LATE** after **9AM** and **1PM** may be asked to wait for the caret session to end before they can bring the child into the room.

WELLIES FOR THE GARDEN



Please could parents of children in the **3-4's** bring their child some wellies to leave at nursery for play on the grass area, which can get quite muddy!

Please ensure they are labelled with your child's **NAME** and **CLASS**.
